#### **Ghost and Legends** of Fort Liquordale

#### Fort Myers Legends & Legacies

The founding fathers of Fort Myers may have been inventors, cattle ranchers and railroad men, but the gentler sex did more than their fair share to turn a cowboy town into one of southwest Florida's leading cultural centers. This tour looks at the history of Fort Myers through the remarkable lives of several founding females who used their influence, intellect — and sometimes, their husbands' money — to make the "City of Palms" what it is today

### MIAMI

Miami Beach has been called "a history lesson in 20th-century architecture" and on this tour it's easy to see why. A guide from the Miami Design Preservation League points out postcard-worthy examples of hotels, restaurants and commercial buildings along Ocean Drive, which capture the neighborhood's distinct Art Deco, Mediterranean Revival and MiMo (Miami Modern) styles. Highlights of the tour are visits to several hotel interiors, where you can still see remnants of what life and luxury were like in the years leading up to World War II.

## **NAPLES**

#### Historic Tour of Old Naples

A quaint historic neighborhood surrounded by colorful beach cottages, banyan trees and coconut palms, Old Naples became a cold-weather retreat for some of the wealthiest families in the country. Hear about the colorful cast of snowbirds who visited and settled in the area, as you wind through the streets and alleys of Third Street South to view some of the city's original cottages and structures. This one-mile tour begins with a look inside Palm Cottage - the city's oldest house - and ends with a short film in the Historical Society's theater.
