Stroll along the infamous Creek Street boardwalk marking Ketchikan's colorful past and salty beginnings back in the town's lawless years.
- Visit cultural centers including Totem Heritage Center or the Tongass Historical Museum and learn about the local native culture. The Southeast Alaska Discovery Center offers information about Alaska's wilderness areas, industries, ecosystems, wildlife, natural resources, public lands, and native cultures.

- Potlatch Park is a family owned Totem Park with totem poles carved by a local carver, a clan house, and for those with an interest in rare antique weapons and automobiles, they have one of the finest collections.
- Totem Bight State Park offers a rare totem circle, clan house, and access to one of Ketchikan's scenic shorelines.
- Saxman Native Village and Totem Park maintains the world's largest collection of authentic totem poles. Walk through the park as your guide brings to life the legends of the totems.

- Feel the mist of Beaver Falls as a beautiful waterfall cascades 175 feet down the mountainside.
