

Job Descriptions - There are 12 positions available.

Rental Attendants will facilitate tours and rentals sales, help fit customers to bikes for tours and rentals, and educate tourists on local sites and where to ride. This position entails being a quality bike ambassador for the city of Boston and Urban AdvenTours. Rental attendants will also learn the ins and outs of a bike shop that also provides tours to customers from all around the globe. The **wage is \$11.00/hour.**

Sales Helpers will work in the Urban Cycles Bike Shop. Employees will sell bicycles, merchandise, and bicycles components / accessories. This is a great position to learn more about bicycles and the bicycle industry. Some experience with bike repair is preferred. The **wage is \$11.00/hour.**

Work Schedule: You should expect to work about 40/hours per week. Please note that the weather can have an effect on your work hours.

Work Start Dates: We are looking for candidates who can start work as early as possible. The closer to **May 15**, the better.

Work Finish Dates: We are looking for candidates who can stay until **September.** However, we want you to be honest about your work finish date. We try really hard to accommodate students' requests and all we ask is that you are honest upfront, you work hard, and you give us sufficient notice of your last day of work.





Uniform: While at work, employees are required to wear UA apparel and closed-toed shoes. All employees must always carry a multi-tool and a company phone. Employees are expected to show up looking clean and professional. Helmets should be worn at all times while riding (Test rides around the building do not require a helmet, but should use the utmost professionalism riding the test bicycle). Clothing NOT permitted includes: pants or shirts with holes or tears, sandals, cut offs, loose jewelry such as bracelets or long earrings, and overly loose or baggy clothing.

Housing: You should secure housing in Boston upon receipt of this job offer. Your employer and InterExchange can provide you with housing leads. Please reach out to InterExchange if you are having difficulty finding housing.

Cultural Opportunities: Participants will be educated in the rich culture and history of Boston and will be expected to share this knowledge with visitors. Participants will also interact with customers from around the world and all over the United States. This is a great chance for curious individuals to learn about the diversity of American culture. Participants will also interact with locals including co-workers, walk-in customers, bike commuters, industry representatives, bike advocacy partners, and neighboring business owners. Participants will work right in downtown Boston, providing easy access to all parts of the city.
