TERMS & CONDITIONS

Vehicles

Although the company endeavors to operate open top buses on all of its services, it reserves the right to operate enclosed top buses with functional windows or similar tour vehicles from time to time, especially in bad weather. The company operates a timetabled service and, for safety reasons, reserves the right to refuse your access to travel on a particular departure. For safety reasons you are required to remain seated at all times while the vehicle is in motion. No responsibility will be accepted by PST for any injuries, however caused, relating to customers not adhering to the above regulations. As we operate a Hop-on, Hop-off service, seats cannot be guaranteed.

Lost Property

You are responsible for all your personal items carried onto the vehicle. PST will not be responsible for any items left on the vehicle. Luggage may not be carried on board any PST tour vehicle. Ticket Agents

General Conditions

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The passengers who are offered Tours of Philadelphia by Philadelphia Sightseeing Tours (PST) acknowledge and agree to the terms and conditions set forth below covering the published tours as follows:

Safety

Please listen to all safety instructions provided by the company. All guests are to remain seated while the bus is in motion. If you need to exit the vehicle, please let your Tour Guide and Driver know ahead of time. Please keep all extremities inside the bus/trolley at all times. Umbrellas are not permitted to be opened on the vehicle. If you require special assistance, please speak to one of our Ticket Agents, Tour Guides, Drivers, or contact our office at 215-922-2300 extension "0".

Tickets

You should keep your ticket in a safe place as replacements will not be issued. You will not be permitted to use any (PST) tour service unless you have a valid ticket for the entirety of your purchased journey. The ticket remains the property of the company and must be produced for inspection and, if requested to do so, be surrendered upon demand to an authorized company official. Hop-on Hop-Off tour tickets entitle you to use all Philadelphia Sightseeing Tour services during operational hours, commencing at the date and time printed on your ticket. Extensions will not be given. Hop-on, Hop-Off tickets do not entitle you to travel on a specific service at a specific time. Guests are also provided a Philadelphia Sightseeing Tours wristband to identify our guests. Wristbands must be worn during the ENTIRE duration of your purchased ticket date(s). Night Tours DO NOT require a wristband.

Tickets Are Not Transferable

Look after your ticket. If you lose it, you lose your riding privileges. Passengers found traveling without a valid ticket will be charged the full daily fare.

Children

A child is defined as 4-10 years old. Only one child under 4 years accompanied by one adult may travel free as long as they do not occupy a seat to the exclusion of a fare-paying passenger. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Departure Points And Times

The company endeavors to provide departure points and times for the service which are as accurate as possible. However, the company reserves the right to alter such departure points and times without notice to you, as circumstances require.

Tour Changes Or Withdrawals

PST reserves the right to cancel, change, withdraw or substitute any tour at any time for any reason, including insufficient tour participants. If the company cancels a tour it shall have no responsibility other than the refund of the ticket price or part thereof. The company reserves the right to deviate from the route of service in the event of marches, parades or when it deems responsibly prudent to do so in the event of circumstances beyond control.
