1. **USE & OPERATION.** Renter represents that they are capable of operating the rental equipment lawfully and safely, and therefore agrees to do so. Renter represents that the equipment is in good working order, condition and repair. Renter is responsible for noting any damage on the back of this form prior to taking possession of the equipment. Furthermore, renter shall advise if there are any safety issues regarding any of the equipment provided before utilizing. Renter agrees to obey ALL state and local laws ;(under which this agreement shall be governed and constructed by). PFD's + Leashes are always required.

2. **RENTAL & OTHER FEES.** TEA agrees to rent the above described equipment for a fee. As the Renter is responsible for the equipment, they shall not damage or misuse it, and if damage or theft does occur, the Renter agrees to pay all costs associated with repairing any damage or loss. If damage meets or exceeds the MSRP of the item, or if the item is stolen, Renter shall pay TEA the cost to replace the item (not to exceed the MSRP) including all associated shipping costs. Renter agrees to have the equipment back to TEA by the agreed upon date & time. Renter agrees to pay penalty of \$125 (above any other rental fees) each, if any equipment is not returned in a timely manner as agreed. Renter gives TEA permission to charge the late fee & tax on the credit card provided by the renter. The Renter agrees that these fees are not refundable.

3. **RIDER LIMITATIONS.** I certify that all users know how to swim, weigh less than 290 pounds, and are not pregnant.

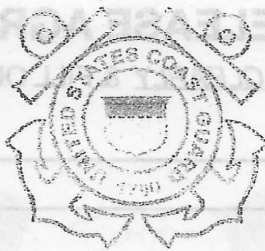
4. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK.** I understand and acknowledge that use of an SUP has a potential for injury or death to persons, including the user, and for loss damage to property, including the SUP, and I assume the risk of such injury, loss or damage.

5. **RELEASE WAIVER OF LIABILITY INDEMNITY AGREEMENT.** I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE TEA, ITS OWNERS AND EMPLOYEES, FROM ALL LIABILITY on account of injury to me whether caused by the negligence or gross negligence of Triad ECO Adventures. I HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY, SAVE HOLD HARMLESS AND DEFEND TEA, IT'S OWNERS AND EMPLOYEES, from any and all claims related to my use of the SUP. I HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR RISK OF BODLY INJURY OR ILLNESS due to the negligence or gross negligence of Triad ECO Adventures or otherwise while participating in the use of the SUP. I expressly acknowledge and agree that the activities of the SUP involve risk of injury or illness. I further expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law of North Carolina. I HAVE READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNED THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT and further agree that no oral representation, statement or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.

US Coast Guard SUP Rules Awareness and Agreement

The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) has determined that SUP boards operated outside a surfing, swimming or bathing area are "vessels" under USCG regulations. The following refers to what that means for you when outside those specific areas.

Life Jackets:

- Each paddler 13 years of age or older must have a USCG-approved Type I, II, III, or appropriate Type V (see below) life jacket. According to the USCG, it doesn't have to be worn, although that's certainly the wisest plan, and one which is strongly recommended.
- A child 12-years old or younger must wear their USCG-approved life jacket.
- The jacket must be in "serviceable condition," without rips, tears or deterioration that will diminish its performance.
- The jacket must be of an appropriate size and fit for the wearer.
- A Type V jacket can be used as long as it's USCG-approved and applicable for the activity.
- Belt pouch-type inflatable PFDs must be worn on the person to meet the life jacket regulation. For other types of inflatable PFDs, check the approval description printed on the unit for restrictions.
- For all life jackets, be sure to read the label to know if special requirements pertain to that device.

Other Required Gear:

- A whistle or other sound producing device must be carried to warn other boaters.
- If you're on the water after sunset, you need to have a flashlight, or similar lighting device, to warn other boaters.

What You Need to Do:

- As the operator of a vessel, you need to follow the Navigation Rules. A copy can be provided for you upon request, or go to www.navcen.uscg.gov
- You are also required to report any boating accident or injury to the local reporting authority, either the USCG or other agency that has been delegated that authority.
