2019 Exclusive Charter Rates

Daytime Cruises: (Before 5pm)	\$1100	\$1300	\$1300
Evening Cruises: (After 5pm)	\$1400	\$1600	\$2650 (3 Hour Minimum)

Off-Peak Months (Late-May, June, Labor Day – Columbus Day), deduct \$50/hour from the above base rate.

The above prices are for a 2 Hour Charter (3 Hour Charter on Saturday Evening). Additional cruising time can be added in 30 minute increments for an additional **\$350 per 30 minutes**. Dockside time can be added for an additional **\$400 per hour dockside**.

Charter rates provide for exclusive use of the Grand Lady (facilities on board, Captain & crew to operate vessel, cash bar, and sail rain or shine). **Food and beverage packages are in addition to charter rate.** All food and beverage served on board must be purchased from Grand Lady Cruises.

Above rates are for charters sailing from and returning to the Grand Lady's home port at Buffalo RiverWorks (359 Ganson St., Buffalo, NY 14203). Additional dock sites may be available for additional fees including \$350 per hour travel fee.

Severe Weather Policy: *In the case of severe weather, a decision will be made at time of departure. If the Captain determines it is too threatening to sail, the event will take place dockside and a banquet room fee of \$400/hour will be charged in lieu of charter fee.*

Deposits and Payments:

- **50% of charter rate due at time of reservation** (10 days after reservation if booked during off-season)
- **Balance of charter rate due 30 days prior to cruise date.** (Deposit forfeited and cruise cancelled if not paid by 14 days prior to cruise date)
- Food and beverage orders due 30 days prior to cruise, guarantee counts and payment due 10 days prior to cruise
- Additional fee of \$150/hour to apply to charters without alcohol service
- In case of any unforeseen increase in business cost, sur charges may apply

Vessel Capacities:

- **Cocktail Reception/Cruise Only: 100**
- **Plated Lunch or Dinner: 88**
- **Buffet: 78**
