

Not sure where to go?.... Here's what we recommend.

West Cruiser Loop (7 miles) - This 7 mile ride brings you through the breathtaking scenery of Palisade's Fruit & Wine Country. Ride along the Vineyards and Orchards while staying off the busy roads. To begin this ride from our shop, we recommend heading north on Main St.- going across the train tracks, then taking a left on W 1st St.

Blue Beryl Winery (51) Rating: A Cost:

As you are riding west on W 1st St., you will come to a 4-way stop with Alberta St. You can take a right, head north on Alberta, then take a left on G 7/10 Rd. Head west on G 7/10 Rd for 1.4 miles. Blue Beryl Winery will be on your left-hand side (south of G 7/10). This winery is fairly new and comes highly recommended by our staff and Palisade locals. This winery is run by an ambitious mother - daughter duo! Be sure to find them and get to know their story. This winery is known for their red wine. *The Blue Beryl is closed Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

Carboy Winery (40) Rating: A Cost: \$20 / 5 wines

As you leave Blue Beryl, you'll want to head east on G 7/10 Rd. just until you get to 36 3/10 Rd. Take a right on 36 3/10 Rd. and head south. You will come to an intersection with G Rd - take a right. As you head west on G Rd. - 0.6 miles down on your right-hand side will be Carboy Winery. Carboy is known for their incredible wine, ambiance and remarkable vineyards. Yes, Denver folks, we know there is a tasting room in Denver - this is where the wine is made. If you're lucky, you can rent out the Estate House on the property for an unforgettable experience.

Maison La Belle Vie (38) Rating: A+ Cost: \$15 / 4 wines

Right across the street from Carboy Winery is the well-known Maison La Belle Vie. Maison has a full service restaurant/bistro that tends to get busy. Reservations very well may be needed due to high demand. Maison is known for its outstanding wine, good food and unforgettable ambiance. Wines consist of everything from Reds, Whites, Rose and more.

Colorado Vintners (43) Rating: B+ Cost:

As you leave Maison La Belle Vie, head back east towards Downtown Palisade on G Rd. Be careful, as G Rd and Hwy 6 come together, traffic can get busy. Just after G Rd and Hwy 6 intersect, on your left-hand side you will see Colorado Vintners. Known as the afternoon hangout spot, Vintners offers both indoor and outdoor seating and is a great place to catch the sunset. Colorado Vintners doesn't open until 2pm, but stays open until 8pm. Dogs are welcome on the patio and they also serve Rocky Mountain Pizza, as well as charcuterie boxes. Live music isn't uncommon here.

Colterris Collections (44) Rating: A Cost: \$15 / 5 wines

Just down the street, on the same side of Hwy 6 is Colterris Collections. Similar to its other 2 locations in Palisade, Colterris Collections offers some of the best wine in the Grand Valley. The newest addition to Colterris' repertoire offers a great setting that may not get the crowds as the other 2 locations tend to get. Nothing out of the ordinary for Colterris here, same great wine and great people.

Talon Wines at St. Kathryn's Rating: B Cost:

Across Hwy 6 from Colterris Collections is the 3 in 1 Talon Wines at St. Kathryn's. This location consists of Talon Winery, St. Kathryn's Winery and the Meadery of the Rockies. A great spot to get a variety of wine. Talon Winery will be more on the traditional side of wine, while St. Kathryn's and The Meadery of the Rockies are known for their fruit flavored wine. From blueberry, to peach, honey and everything in between. A great location for those with a sweeter taste for wine.

As you leave this location, the quickest way to the shop is to head east on Hwy 6. Look for Main St. - take a left. The shop is about 4 blocks north. Remember to ride safe, and obey all rules of the road. If you are too impaired to ride or drive, please give us a call. We will come pick you up for \$10/person.
