

# Commercial Pilot Add-on Requirements

## Minimum Flight Requirements

In aircraft:

- 150hrs Total Time
  - 100hrs in powered aircraft
  - 50hrs helicopters
- 100hrs PIC
  - 35hrs helicopters

In helicopters

- 35hrs PIC
  - 10hrs cross country
- 20hrs training
  - 5hrs solely reference by instrument
  - 2hr cross country greater than 50NM
  - 2hr night cross country greater than 50NM
- 10hrs solo or performing the duties of PIC
  - 1 cross country
    - 3 points
    - 1 leg greater than 50NM
  - 5hrs night

## Other Requirements

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Class medical
  - Visit [www.faa.gov/licenses\\_certificates/medical\\_certification](http://www.faa.gov/licenses_certificates/medical_certification)
- Checkride

## Expected costs

During the course of training, we can include Class A and Class B external load training for no additional cost. Due to the difficulty of learning these machines, expect to take longer than the minimum requirements. In most cases, the syllabus will be mostly dual training, with little to no solo time. For the calculation of this cost we will assume the pilot meets all of the non-helicopter specific requirements. Please contact us for a more accurate quote.

Dual: 50hrs \* \$320/hr = \$19,200

Checkride: \$800

Total: \$20,000
