### KEYHOLE FALLS TRAIL

The Keyhole Falls Trail will be closed from April 1st - November 15th yearly. This seasonal closure is in place to support the recovery of the Grizzly Bear population.

### MEAGER SLIDE

The Meager Creek FSR is closed indefinitely and there is no access to Meager Hot Springs. On August 6, 2010 a massive avalanche on Capricorn Creek, the second largest such natural disaster in Canadian history, swept down into Meager Creek and pushed its way down into a portion of the Lillooet River.

### THE PEMBERTON ICEFIELD

The southernmost of the series of very large icefields studding the Pacific Ranges of the southern Coast Mountains in British Columbia. These icefields are popular with snowmobilers in the winter.

- ### Points of Interest
- ONE MILE LAKE:** Nature trail and boardwalk around the lake, many portions wheelchair accessible. Doggie beach at north end of lake.
  - NAIRN FALLS:** 1.5 km walking trail to falls, campground, picnic area, and washrooms. Trail to One Mile Lake.
  - NATURE CENTRE:** Environmental displays and interactive learning opportunities for all ages.
  - PEMBERTON MUSEUM:** Pemberton history displayed in original hand hewn log homes. Open May - October.
  - GOLF:** 2 - 18 hole golf courses.
  - SHADOW LAKE INTERPRETIVE FOREST:** Over 6 km of trails. Many opportunities for wildlife viewing and exploration.
  - JOFFRE LAKES PROVINCIAL PARK:** Jagged peaks, glaciers and trail to 3 pristine turquoise lakes.
  - FARMS:** Potato farms, markets, u-pick farms and cattle.
  - SHOPPING:** A variety of unique shops.
