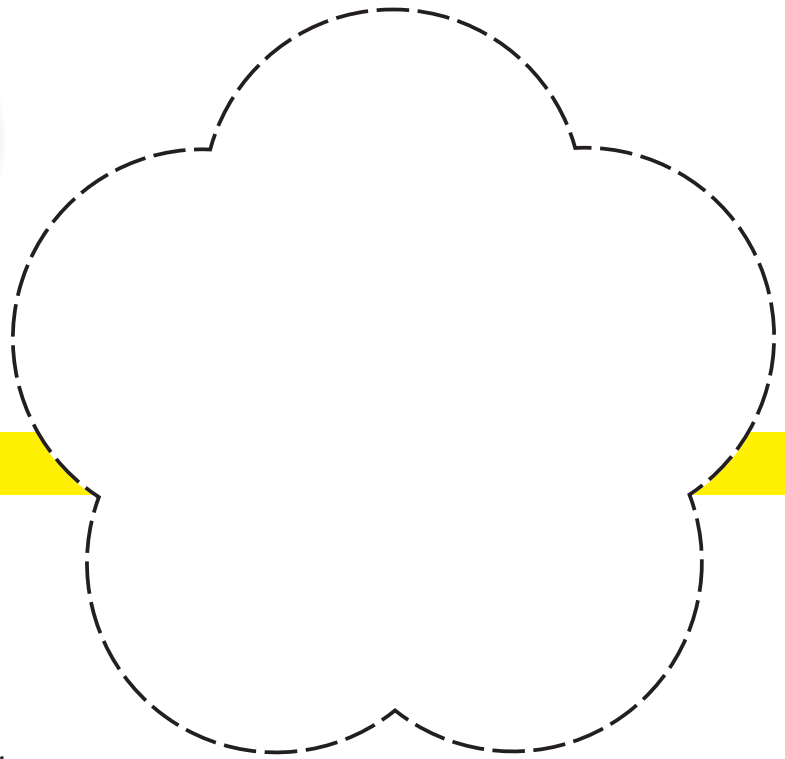


Flower Garden Counting



What you need:

- Construction Paper (all colors)
- Scissors
- Marker
- Glue Stick
- 10 – 20 Popsicle Sticks
- 40 – 80 Paper Clips (green or color them with a green permanent marker)

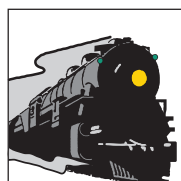
How to make your garden:

- Print and cut out the tracing pattern
- Trace the flower onto your construction paper and cut out
- Cut small circles for the center of the flower and glue on
- Using a marker, write numbers 1 – 20 or 1 – 10 in the center circle of the flower
- Glue the flower to the popsicle stick
- Add paper clips to the bottom of the popsicle sticks as leaves

What you do:

- Plant your garden as you practice counting your numbers

Note: For a math flash card variation, put the math problem in the center of the flower and write the answer on the back. Show your child the flower and let them solve the problem.
