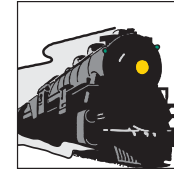
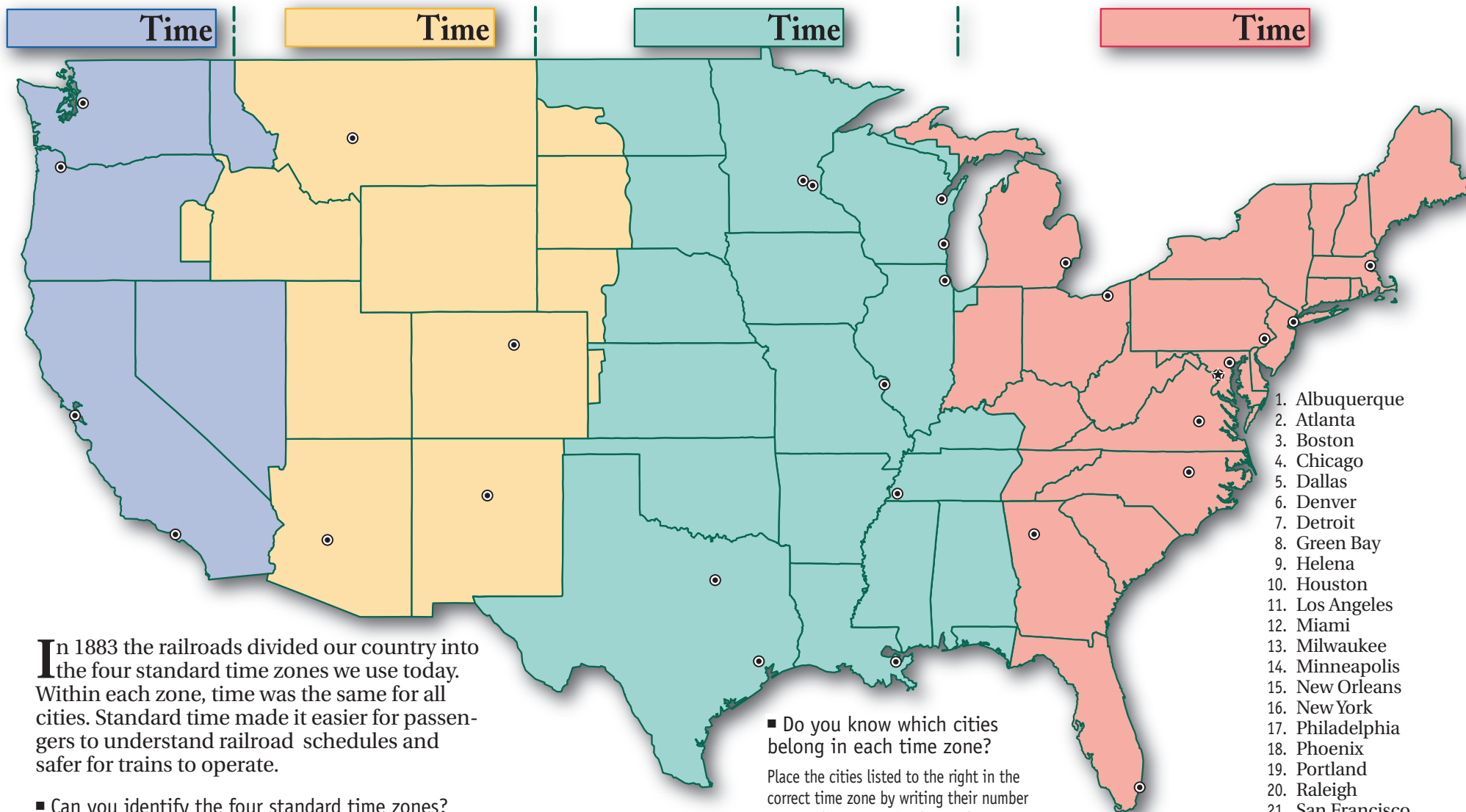


Standard Time
