

# Handprint Monkey



## What you need

- Washable paint or finger paint
- Construction paper (2 or 3 sheets, one should be white)
- Markers
- Googly eyes
- Scissors
- Glue stick

## What to do:

- Take a piece of white construction paper and markers, and draw a tree or some vines.
- Take your finger paint (any color you wish) and cover the palm of your hand and fingers.
- Spread your fingers and thumb out and then press your hand print to the paper, lining up your middle finger and ring finger to sit on one of the tree branches or vine.
- Wash and dry hands.
- Using a marker draw three circles on a sheet of darker construction paper, one large and two medium for the head and the ears. (Example: purple)
- Using a marker, draw two small circles, and an oval that's as wide as the larger circle, on a sheet of lighter colored construction paper for the mouth and inner ears. (Example: lavender)
- Take scissors and cut out the circles and the ovals.
- Using a glue stick, glue the smaller, lighter colored circles on top of the two medium, darker colored circles to make the ears.
- Using your glue stick, then glue the ears onto the back of the large circle, then turn it over and glue on the oval for the lower half of the face.
- Glue on your googly eyes and color on a nose and mouth.
- Glue the completed head over the top of the imprint of the pinky to complete your handprint monkey.
