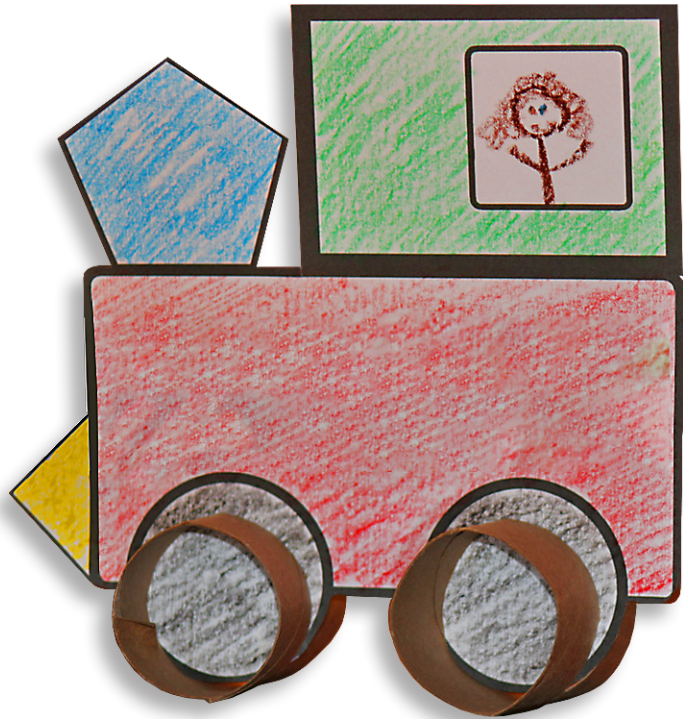


Shapes of a Train

shapes?**

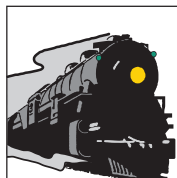


What you need:

- Card stock
- Paper towel or toilet paper roll cut into 2 inch pieces
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers

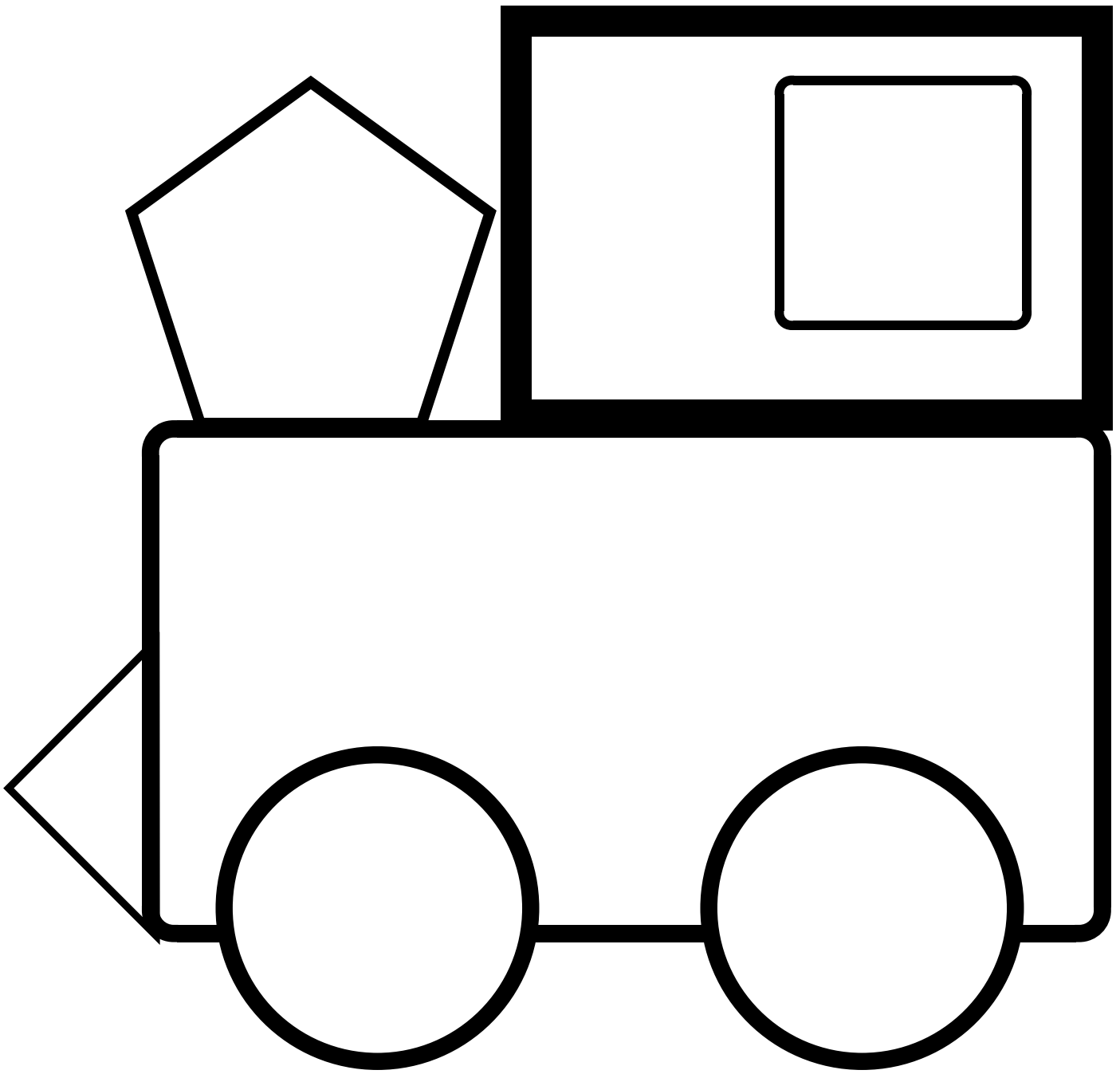
What to do:

- Color the completed train with your markers or crayons
- Cut out the train
- Cut a slit down the center of the toilet paper roll. The slit should be along the circle rather than cutting it all the way open so it can be slid over the wheels at the bottom of the train.
- Slide the train into the slits of the toilet paper roll, this will hold the train upright.

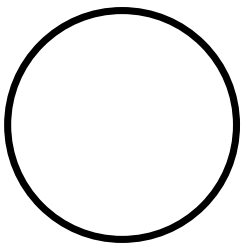

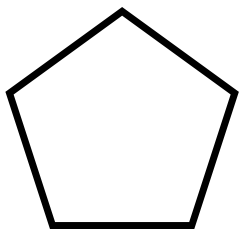

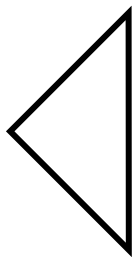
How many shapes can you find? Count the shapes that make up the train.

circle



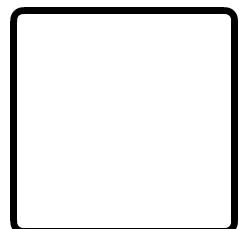
pentagon



triangle



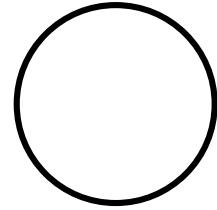
rectangle



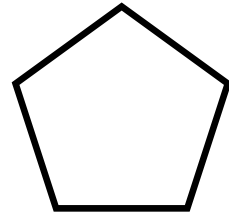
square

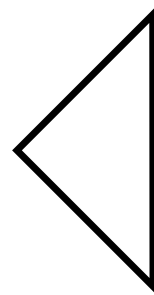
PENTAGON
