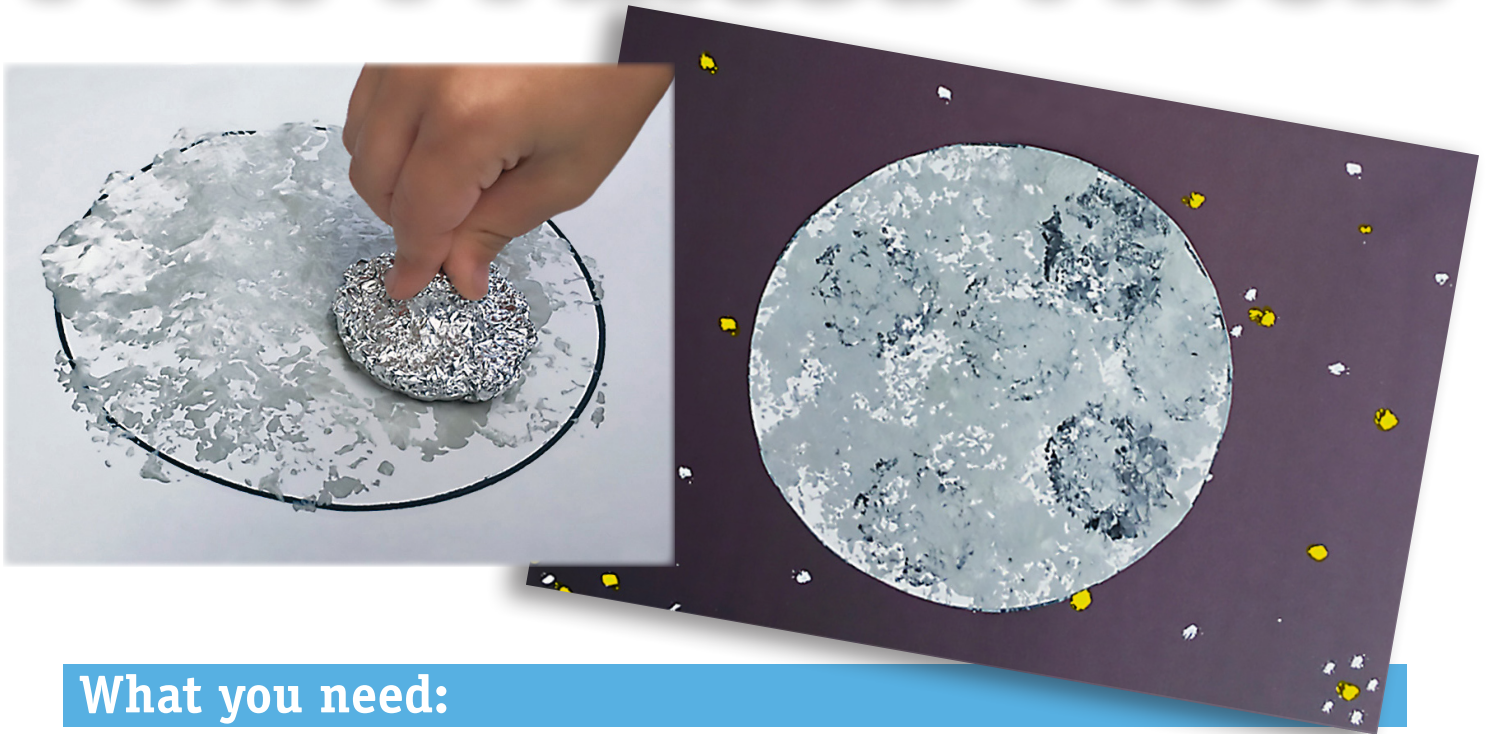


# Foil-Printed Moon



## What you need:

- Foil
- Measuring cup or small cup
- The large circle template printed
- Black construction paper
- Plate (paper will work)
- Gray paint (if you don't have gray, mix black and white together)
- Black and white paint (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Paint brush
- Yellow and white paint

## What to do:

- Make a foil 'stamp' by taking a piece of foil paper, crumpling it up and pressing it into the measuring cup. Use your thumb to make a dip in the middle of the foil until one of the sides is slightly higher and can be used as a 'handle' for the stamper. (Make one stamper for each color of paint)
- Put a good bit of the paint onto the plate.
- Take the sheet of white paper with the circle printed on it and set it on the table.
- Using the bottom/flat side of the foil 'stamp' dip it into the paint and dab it onto the circle. Feel free to mix up the colors. Keep repeating this until you're happy with your moon.
- Let the paint dry.
- Take scissors after the paints dried and cut out the moon.
- Glue the moon to the black sheet of construction paper.
- Using a paint brush, dab on some stars.
