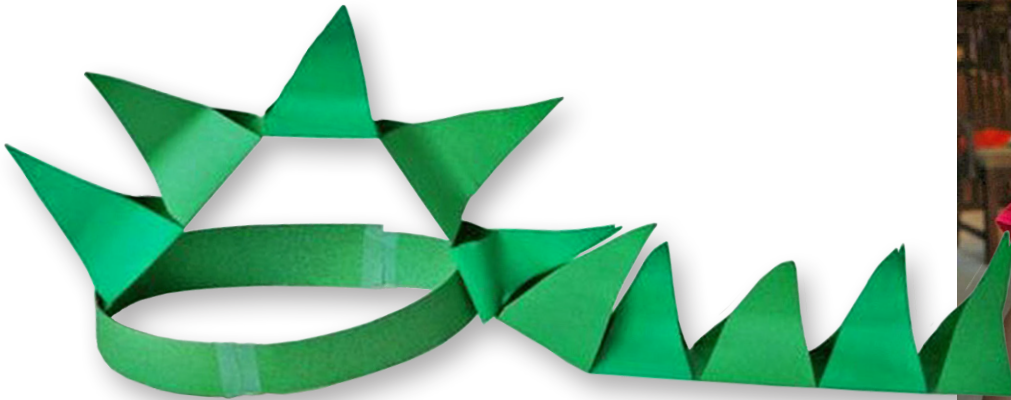


Dinosaur Hat*

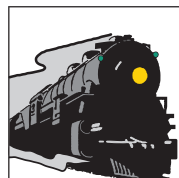


What you need:

- 3 sheets of construction paper (any color you want your dinosaur to be)
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Tape

What to do:

- Cut four 1" strips length-wise (long side) of a sheet of your construction paper.
- Take the other two pieces of paper and cut 2" strips width-wise (short side). This should make 10 strips total, 5 out of each sheet.
- Take one of the 2" strips, fold in half and repeat on all the strips.
- Draw a triangle with the tip ending at the open end.
- Take your scissors and cut the lines of the triangle.
- Open up the folded sheet, these are your spikes.
- Take two of the 1" strips of paper and glue the spikes in a row down the strip of paper.
- Let the glue dry.
- Take the remaining two 1" strips and fit them around your head to make the headband. Use tape to secure it as a circle.
- Once the glue is dry, take the spike pieces to the headband from front to back. One needs to trail down.
