

Paper Plate Spinning Wheel*

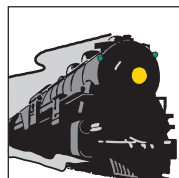


What you need:

- Paper Plate
- Ruler
- Markers or Tempura Paint
- Foam Sheet
- Skewer
- Pencil
- Glue Gun

What to do:

- Take the wooden skewer and poke a hole through the center of the paper plate.
- Using the ruler, draw a line across the center of the paper plate and then again from the top to bottom making a cross. Keep drawing lines until you have what looks like drawn pieces of pie.
- Using markers or paint, color the pieces of the pie.
- Take scissors and cut two small circles from the foam sheet.
- Use the wooden skewer to poke holes through the center of each circle.
- Put one of the foam circles over the hole on the paper plate and push the skewer through the foam circle and the hole in the plate.
- Take the other foam circle and place on the other side of the plate.
- Break off the tip of the skewer.
- Take the glue gun and glue the foam circles to the plate make sure you get it around the skewer too!
