Island Flight Terms and Conditions

PASSENGER WEIGHTS:

Due to safety and legal requirements for the operating weight of an aircraft, it is essential that accurate weights of all passengers and baggage are obtained.

Children & Infants:

Infants are classified as a passenger who has not reached his or her third birthday and may travel on their parent's or guardian's lap with a special seatbelt attachment.

Children are classified as 3 to 12 years inclusive and may share a seat if their combined weight does not exceed 77 kg and provided the seat belt will accommodate two children.

All passengers 13 years of age and over must occupy a single seat.

PASSENGER ACCEPTANCE:

SAS reserves the right to refuse the carriage of passengers who are suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs are disruptive or who do not comply with flight or ground crew instructions.

CHECK IN TIMES:

A minimum of 30 minutes prior to the stated aircraft departure time at Geraldton and a minimum of 15 minutes of the stated aircraft departure time from the island. SAS reserves the right to refuse the carriage of passengers arriving after close of check-in.

BAGGAGE:

The maximum baggage allowance (including carry on) is 10kg per person in soft sided bags or as agreed upon.

WEATHER:

Inclement weather may result in a reduction in the maximum payload allowed on the day.

PARKING:

Vehicles can be parked in the SAS car park which is located on Gordon Garret Drive next to Hertz Car Rental.

CANCELLATION TERMS:

Unless otherwise agreed between the client and SAS, cancellation of any flight(s) including private hire after confirmation is subject to the following:

- More than 7 days – no charge
- 7 days to 72 hours – 25% of quoted price
- 72 to 24 hrs – 50% of quoted price
- 24 hrs or less – 100% of quoted price

An administration fee of \$33.00 will be incurred on all refunds processed.

Vaccination Policy

Due to the threat of COVID-19 within Western Australia, Shine Aviation has implemented the following vaccination policy to minimise the risk to its team, clients and passengers. All passengers travelling on Shine Aviation aircraft or receiving flight training need to provide validation of vaccination unless exempt as follows:

- From the 1st of January 2022 first dose received prior to date of departure.
- From the 1st of February 2022 both doses received prior to date of departure.

Children 12 years and under are exempt from the above.

Emails are only monitored during business hours.
