TRIP DURATION / DEPARTURE

2 days and 2 nights duration of 46 hours.
Departs 3.00pm Mon, Wed and Fri and returns Wed, Fri and Sun respectively.

GUEST NUMBERS

A minimum of 6 up to a maximum of 12 guests with 2 crew.

AGE POLICY

Children aged 4 years and over can travel on this tour at full adult rates. Please advise any child ages at time of booking. As Whitsunday Adventurer is an active sailing vessel our crew will be involved in sailing and operational activities and parents will need to remain responsible for their child's behaviour whilst on tour.

STANDARD INCLUSIONS

Services of the skipper and crew, all meals and snacks, charcoal filtered water, tea and coffee, snorkelling equipment and basic tuition, stinger suits, bed linen, marina levies and fees.

EXTRA INCLUSIONS

Use of stand-up paddleboards, foredeck spa, bath towels.

MEALS ONBOARD

Meals are included in the fare and are freshly prepared on board; we source quality Australian Produce. Special diets can be catered for though may incur an additional cost and should be advised at time of booking. Breakfast x 2, morning teas x 2, lunch x 1, afternoon snacks x 2, evening meals x 2.

ACCOMMODATION ONBOARD


6 x single bunks - dorm-style with share bathroom facilities.

BOOKING AND RECONFIRMATION PROCESS

After completing a booking, the guest(s) will receive a confirmation email with their boarding pass - as long as we have the guests email address.

The guest is required to reconfirm their booking with Explore Whitsundays no later than 72 hours before the tour departure time. Phone (+61) 07 4967 7555 to confirm.

Closer to the departure of their tour, the guest(s) will receive an email with instructions on how to complete their waiver. We require each guest to fill this out no later than 48 hours before the tour departure time.

ALCOHOL POLICY

Guests can bring your own alcohol, wine in bottles is ok, but beer/cider/UDL's etc in cans only, please. Whitsunday Adventurer does not sell soft drinks or bottled water.

LUGGAGE POLICY

There are no luggage storing facilities on any of our vessels nor at the marina. Guests are asked to pre-arrange luggage storage for the duration of their trip. Guests are kindly asked to pack lightly for their trip, in a soft-sided zipless bag.

WHAT TO BRING

Bring clothes, beach towel, toiletries, hat, swimwear, sunscreen, refillable water bottle as charcoal filtered water is available onboard, jacket/sweater, camera, sunglasses, runners or sandals for island walks, alcohol and soft drinks.

TRANSFERS / MEETING POINT

No transfers included.

Crew will meet the guests 30 minutes before departure at Coral Sea Marina (South End) at Meeting Point C.

PARKING

Guests who drive can park cars at Coral Sea Marina. A fee applies to park at this marina, and guests purchase parking tickets from the machines in the car park (credit cards or coins) at own cost.

PRIVATE CHARTERS

Whitsunday Adventurer is available for private charter for groups of up to 12. We can tailor itineraries, duration and meal options. EXAMPLE ITINERARY

The following itinerary is an example of a scheduled cruise. All cruises are subject to weather and tidal conditions and the Captain's professional judgement in putting together the best itinerary to keep guests happy, safe and well.

DAY 1

Meet your crew at Coral Sea Marina 30 minutes before departure for a headcount. Adventurer departs at 3:00pm, sail to overnight stop, Nara Inlet on Hook Island. Time to watch the sunset over the islands.

DAY 2

After Breakfast, sail to Hill Inlet, for a walk up to a lookout. Visit Whitehaven Beach for a swim, paddleboard or spend time relaxing, then mid-afternoon sail to Border Island for an amazing Whitsunday Sunset. Time for a relaxing heated spa on the foredeck. Overnight anchorage at Stonehaven.

DAY 3

After breakfast, time to go for a paddle or snorkelling on the island coral reefs teeming with fish and beautiful corals. After morning tea it's time to leave the islands, sailing across the Whitsunday Passage back to the Marina in Airlie Beach.

Our trip departs 3.00pm Monday, Wednesday, Friday and returns at 1:00pm on the Wednesday, Friday and Sunday respectively.


Your Explore Whitsundays Trip Guide For Whitsunday Adventurer

Pre-Trip Travel Information

- ★ Please call the Explore Whitsundays reservations team on +61 (0) 7 4967 7555 at least 72 hours before your departure to re-confirm your booking.
- ★ You will receive an email allowing you to complete your waiver form online. Please complete this no later than 48 hours before your tour.
- ★ On the day of the departure, please meet at Coral Sea Marina at 'Meeting Point C' (pictured right) 30 minutes before your trip departs.
- ★ You will be met by one of our Customer Service Team members. There are also toilets and café facilities in the area.

Additional Information

Soft drinks and Alcoholic Beverages



Your trip allows you to 'Bring Your Own' (BYO) alcohol and soft drinks. Please bring what you would like to drink during your trip. Please note that glass is not allowed on board. Bottled wine, champagne and spirits are permitted. This keeps rubbish volume to a minimum and lessens glass breakage opportunities.

Luggage



Please pack your belongings for your trip in a soft sided, zipless bag such as a dry bag, or a shopping/tote bag as pictured. Please use a zipless bag - i.e. your bag must not have a zip on it.

You cannot bring large luggage, hard cases or backpacks on your trip.

There are no luggage storage facilities on any of our boats nor in the Coral Sea Marina. You may be able to store luggage at your accommodation for the duration of your trip. Alternatively, there are places on the main street of Airlie Beach that can store luggage for a small fee.

Seasickness and medication



We do not supply seasickness pills or any other medication on board. Should you need sea sickness pills, please bring them with you. Make sure you bring any medication you will need with you.

Snorkelling Equipment



We supply regular snorkelling masks. If you require a prescription mask, these can be hired from Aqua Dive at the North Village of Coral Sea Marina. We do not supply fins for snorkelling as they can be very damaging to the coral.
