Due to the executive order #146 put in place by Governor Murphy, here are the following guidelines we will be adhering to during the COVID-19 pandemic on all of our trips;

If a reservation does not show up, then we will take walk on's on a first come first served basis if there is room.

Everyone must wear a face covering/mask and gloves on all of our trips.

If you are not feeling well, have any symptoms and/or have a temperature, you will not be allowed on-board.

We have plenty of soap and water in the restrooms and have several Purell hand sanitizer stations all around the boat and we ask that you use them frequently.

Social distancing of 6 feet apart from each other must be adhered to at all times.

Lastly, due to the economic hardship this has put on all of us, we have had to increase our prices and we are no longer offering any discounts or offers of any kind or accepting any discounts or offers that you may have received in the past. Everyone is now the same price. Once the capacity restrictions have been lifted, we will begin to offer them again.

On a positive note, with limiting the daily capacity, there will be no tangled lines and it will feel as if you have the boat practically to yourself!
