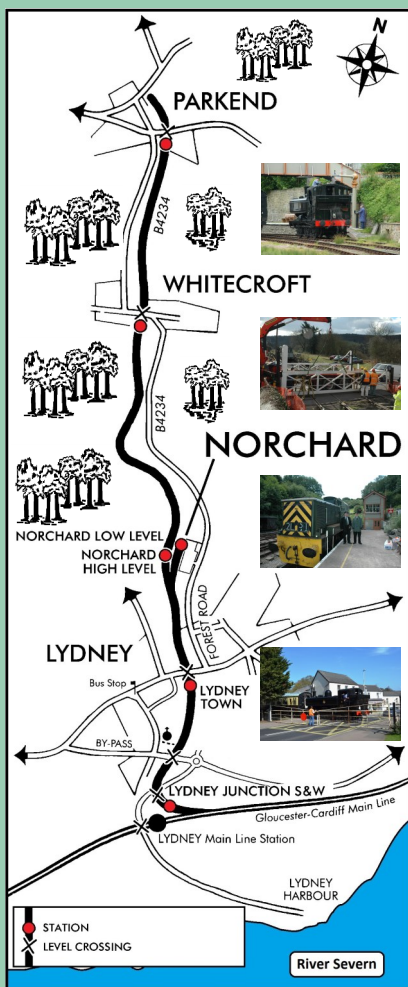

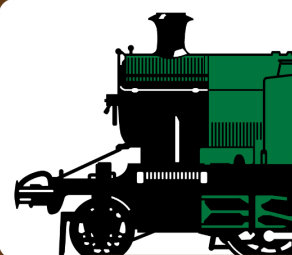


Norchard can be found on the B4234, just north of Lydney.

Lydney is easily accessible from the A40 and A48, M4, M48, M5 and M50.

Lydney is very easy to get to by public transport. Trains stop at Lydney, just 200 yards from the DFR's station at Lydney Junction!

The line began as a tramroad in 1810, and was retained by British Railways until 1985. Today's Dean Forest Railway Society began heritage operations on a small siding at Parkend in 1971, with the aim of preserving and operating the last remaining section of the Severn and Wye Railway, moving to develop the Norchard site in 1978, followed by extensions towards Lydney Junction (1995) and Parkend (2006). The Society has been at the forefront of the growth of the DFR, and today exists as the membership body for the railway. It raises funds for specific projects, recruits volunteers, publishes magazines and books, promotes the railway at events and supports the DFR's ongoing development.
