

Clear Creek County has now given us approval to **open** under COVID-19 virus restrictions. We are committed to protect the health of our guests, employees, and family. The following is the protocol we have adopted and will be in place when you visit.

If you or anyone in your group is feeling unwell, please stay home. We will assist you in rescheduling your trip. We will be reaching out to guests 24 hours before their trip to have them acknowledge that they are not and have not experienced coronavirus symptoms in the last 14 days, including cough, headache, and fever- temperature of 100.4°F/38°C or higher

**Social Distancing** will be practiced by guests and employees

**Face coverings** must be worn by guests, guides, and office staff

- **Limiting People Inside** – Signage at entry will give maximum # allowed in office/shop area. We will continue to offer souvenirs and retail for sale; however, we always will be actively limiting the number of people in the shop.
- **Contact-less** guest check-in, safety orientation and operational training for tours will take place outside rather than inside
- **Waivers** – We would prefer waivers be downloaded and filled out for each participant before arriving to the office to help eliminate contact. We do have waivers available, but will need to be read and signed outside
- **Sanitization** of ATV's and helmets in between tours
- **Office Cleaning Policy** – All restrooms, common spaces, touch screens, doorknobs, handles and high contact areas will be cleaned and sanitized after each tour rotates through
- **Cashless** – In an effort to decrease contact across our staff and guests, we ask that any transactions that occur, for example, photos and souvenirs, be from a credit or debit card.
- **Tipping Your Guide** – We will also be encouraging guests to use platforms such as Venmo to tip their guides.
- **Loitering** will not be allowed inside and outside
- **RZR Tours** will be limited to members of the same household
- **ATV passengers** are limited to be members of the same household
- **ATV Tours** are limited to 8 people of 1 group.
- **ATV Tours** of 2-4 people can be mixed, social distancing required
  
- **Employee Protocols** – We will be screening our guide and guest service staff daily for symptoms. Required facial coverings will be worn by all employees
- Daily symptom screening including temperature readings and questioning.
- Assigned workstations that are 6' apart for indoor employees.
- Frequent hand washing throughout the day. Access to hand sanitizer.
- Employees will be updated daily of any new protocols as conditions change
