Journey to Waimea Canyon

Ride along the mountain to overlook Waimea Canyon, the “Grand Canyon of the Pacific,” including a visual history of Old Koloa Town, circa 1834, heart of Hawaii’s first sugar cane plantation, and Waimea, the little town that prospered where Captain Cook first set foot in Hawaii in 1778.



Wailua River Cruise & Grotto

Take a leisurely cruise down the Wailua River to the botanical beauty of the Fern Grotto. Here, the “Hawaiian Wedding Song” is a natural match in this lush environment. The overlook at Opaekaa Falls is another romantic stop that will surely secure your love of our Garden Isle.



Waimea Canyon, Wailua River & Grotto

This excursion combines a visit to Waimea Canyon, “The Grand Canyon of the Pacific,” and a scenic ride up the Wailua River to the Fern Grotto. At Waimea Canyon experience an unsurpassed view of the 2,857 foot deep canyon and the surrounding countryside. Next, stop at a lava rock cropping known as the “Spouting Horn,” a natural salt water geyser that sprays plumes of ocean water high into the air. Then, proceed to the picturesque Wailua River where you’ll board your river boat for a delightful cruise to the Fern Grotto.

After this, we will drive out to Pearl Harbor where you would visit the World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument, home of the USS Arizona Memorial.



Hawaii Monarch’s Tour

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Heavenly Hana Adventure (KAHULUI ONLY)

Take the journey of a lifetime to East Maui. This all-day tour will take you around a beautiful region of the "Magic Isle," showing you some of the most scenic spots not found on any other island of Hawaii. Weave through the 68-mile road to Hana making stops at Keanae Valley Lookout and Waianapanapa State Park which provides grand views of the ocean and surrounding hills. Once in Hana, take in all the charm of this sleepy, rural village.



Haleakala Crater Tour

Up you go from the sugar-cane plain, through Paniolo (Hawaiian cowboy) country, up beyond the protea farms of Kula in Upcountry Maui, then above the tree line to where cacti and rare Hawaiian silverswords grow to the very crest of Haleakala. Known as "House of the Sun," Haleakala's moonlike crater is the size of Manhattan, and the views are a marvel to behold.



Haleakala at Sunset

Experience an Upcountry Maui evening like no other. Watch the spectacular sunset atop Haleakala Crater, Maui's 10,023-foot volcano, dramatically coloring the end of the day. This experience is ideal for both newcomers and repeat visitors to the island of Maui seeking a unique and memorable vacation.



Iao Valley & Maui Tropical Plantation Tram

Visit two of Maui's most beautiful and popular attractions. Your excursion begins with a guided drive to Iao Valley State Park where you'll enjoy a walk in the park and view an impressive valley. Then visit one of Maui's most interesting sights, the Maui Tropical Plantation. Take a 35-minute narrated tram tour through flower fields and fruit orchards. View fields of coffee, bananas, macadamia nuts, papayas, mangoes, and orchids. You will stop along the way for a coconut husking demonstration and photo opportunities. After the tram tour, you will have the chance to walk through beautifully landscaped gardens.



Best of Maui

Venture to three of Maui's top sightseeing attractions. See how sweetly this island's garden grows at the Maui Tropical Plantation – mangoes, papayas, coffee, sugarcane, kalo (Hawaiian taro), coconuts and macadamia nuts – a feast for your camera and samples galore. Iao Needle, the straight up pinnacle at the heart of the Valley Island's western range, is equally picture perfect. Then, extend the adventure down to the sea at Maui Ocean Center – Zagat Survey's top-rated family attraction featuring The Living Reef, Turtle Lagoon, and Hammerhead Harbor.



Beach Day in Maui (KAHULUI ONLY)

This transfer leaves the pier in the mid-morning with a return pickup in the afternoon. Wailea Beach was named "America's Best Beach" in 1999 and consistently wins high ratings on TripAdvisor and Yelp. Popular with both locals and visitors, it is a signature beach of Maui. Umbrellas, beach chairs, and snorkel gear are available for rental at the beach. Visit the Shops at Wailea, a short walk away.



Maui Snorkel Cruise (KAHULUI ONLY)

Take a pleasant boat ride on the ocean on this two-stop snorkel cruise. Just 3 miles off the shores of Maui is Molokini, a volcanic cinder cone that has eroded over the years and now is a Marine Life Conservation District Seabird Sanctuary. Look for brightly colored tropical fish, monk seals, whale sharks, manta rays and harmless white tip sharks. Then stop at Keawala'i on the Makena/Wailea coastline where numerous green sea turtles can be spotted.



Haleakala at Sunrise

This rare opportunity to view paradise from this altitude will be the highlight of your stay. Roberts Hawaii tops off your adventure with an included light snack during your mountaintop visit and a stop at a local favorite for a delicious breakfast on the trip down.



Volcanoes National Park & Rainbow Falls

At Volcanoes National Park, take a drive through the 11 mile Crater Rim that circles Kilauea's summit and make frequent stops to experience firsthand the wonder and unique beauty of Hawaii's volcanoes. View smooth and jagged lava, lava tubes, sulfur banks, and bleak desert areas. Then, explore more of Hilo's surroundings, including Akatsuka Orchid Nursery and Rainbow Falls – a tropical rainforest wonder. Plus, visit Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory and Visitor Center. Not recommended for people who have heart or respiratory problems.



Akaka Falls, Mac Nut Farm & Tropical Gardens

Visit three of Hilo's favorite attractions – Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory, Pane'ewa Rainforest Zoo & Gardens, and Akaka Falls. At the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory you'll observe firsthand the processing of macadamia nuts and have time to visit their popular gift shop and snack bar. At Akaka Falls walk along the one mile pathway through the lush tropical forest before returning to the ship. The Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory is closed on weekends and holidays.



Historic Kona

We'll share Kailua-Kona's history to set the stage for your trip back in time to Puuhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park – an ancient Hawaiian village of refuge for kapu (law) breakers. We'll show you a beautiful scenic view overlooking Kealahou Bay – an underwater preserve and where a monument to Captain Cook stands. Here, Captain Cook sailed in and was received as the god Lono, proved to be a mere mortal and was slain. Visit the Painted Church – the tiny church Belgian priests painted to be a grand cathedral. Experience history as rich as the brew at the Kona coffee factory we'll visit as well.



Tide Pool & Reef Exploration

This tour is ideal for those who wish to explore life underwater at Kahalu'u Beach Park, that was once a Royal Residence and now a marine preserve. This is known as one of Hawaii's best snorkeling beaches where you can swim with the large schools of colorful fish and green sea honu (Turtles in Hawaiian). You can also explore the many tide pools filled with marine life in the shallow clear waters of the lava rocks surrounding the shore or relax on the salt and pepper sand beach under a shady tree to the sounds of the ocean.



Rafting and Snorkeling Adventure

Get up close and personal with the coastline and marine life of the Big Island with this state of the art and environmentally friendly Zodiac adventure. Come along as experienced captains and crews lead you to discover the awe-inspiring natural beauty of Hawaii. Enjoy snorkeling in Kealahou Bay, sea cave and lava tube exploration by raft, and friendly narration of Hawaii's history and folklore. This is definitely a wet and wild adventure that you won't want to miss!
