



1. Access:

The Park is only accessible to people whose physical and mental abilities allow independent practice in accordance with safety requirements.

The staff must be able, always, to have visual and oral contact with each participant.

By paying the entrance fee, you accept all the points of the rules.

One entry to the park entitles you to 3 consecutive hours of activity*

Participants must have accident insurance, wearing closed shoes, long hair tied back and clothing that may cause strangulation is prohibited. The maximum weight is 115 kg.

People who are poorly equipped and/or under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will not be allowed to enter the park.

2. Equipment and access to the courses:

Equipment is provided at the Parc Aventure Chaumont (1 pair of gloves, 1 harness, 2" CLIC-iT" lanyards and 1 pulley).

The safety briefing is compulsory.

The equipment is non-transferable / exchangeable and must be used according to our instructions. The return of the material is final.

Children from 4 to 6 years old evolve on secure courses only. Parents have access to these courses only if they have paid the entrance fee, if they are equipped with a harness and if they have received the safety briefing.

The continuous belay system on cable courses are accessible from 1m25, or 7years old. Children under 14 must be accompanied or supervised by an adult (who may be on the ground or in the course). From the age of 14, children can progress alone on all courses.

It is mandatory to start with a yellow or green course and you agree to only progress on the courses to which you are entitled.

On the courses you evolve 1 by 1 on the games, 2 people maximum on the platforms.

On the zip lines you check that there is no one on the cable and you adapt your speed (braking) to land slowly, legs forward.

3. Safety instructions:

The management reserves the right to interrupt the activity in case of bad weather (wind or risk of storm).

In the event of permanent closure, if you have done less than an hour of activity, Parc Aventure Chaumont offers you 1 voucher for 1 free entry.

We reserve the right to exclude anyone who does not respect the safety instructions and we decline all responsibility in the event of an accident, loss and/or theft of valuables. By participating in the activity, you accept that it involves certain risks and waive any claim, as well as any lawsuit for damages in the event of an accident.

*After 3hr of activity, 10CHF will be charged for each extra hour
