Seaforth Sailing Club offers group activities, quarterly regattas, weekly and monthly member races, group excursions, and clinics for its members.

Our Affiliate Clubs include: Sailing Ventures in Lake Tahoe, Aventura Sailing in Dana Point, Blue Pacific Sailing in Marina Del Rey, Spinnaker Sailing and San Francisco Sailing Co. in San Francisco, and Santa Barbara Sailing.

To join the Seaforth Sailing Club there is a one-time membership fee of \$249, then monthly dues of \$30 with a minimum commitment of 12 months. Your monthly dues can be applied towards rental fees for that month. No port or docking fees.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Membership Terms

Membership has a minimum term of 12 months. After completing 12 months of membership, a member may cancel this agreement with 30 day written notice at anytime, this includes former members who rejoin. After the first year, if a member wishes to cancel their membership and then rejoin at a later date, he/she may rejoin for \$99 subscription fee (and pay any outstanding dues if applicable). Memberships cannot be put on hold or suspension. Early termination of Membership may only be completed upon payment of remaining terms or periods in first year. SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB reserves the right to cancel any membership at any time. ****Members must use their free ASA 101 course within the first year of their membership.****

Member Dues

Monthly (quarterly or annual) dues will be paid automatically every month (quarter or year) by subscribing to a monthly (quarterly or annual) payment agreement by credit card. Quarterly memberships are only offered to members who reside out of state. Members receive one month free if they prepay one full year, dues still disbursed by month or quarter. Dues may be applied toward boat rentals for said month (or quarter) but are not applicable to merchandise, instructional clinics, classes, and other purchases. Unused dues cannot be carried over to the next period. Dues are not transferable and a member may only apply his or her dues toward his or her own rental on a single piece of rental equipment at a time. Dues may not be combined or split between members toward a single piece of rental equipment.

Co-Membership

Member agrees that this agreement is non-transferable. Each member may have one co-member. Co-Membership privileges are available for one additional family member or spouse living at the same address as the Member and for one piece of equipment at a time. Co-members have access to the member's dues and are the responsibility of the main member. Co-members wishing to use sailing equipment must have sufficient experience to do so and must either provide a sailing resume or take a sailing certification course. Additional family members living in the same household may join the Seaforth Sailing Club under their own membership at the standard subscription rate with the initiation fee waived. Member discount may be applied to only one piece of equipment at a time.

Hull Insurance Deductible Waiver

All sailboats from 16' to 54' have Hull Insurance in the event of an accident, with a deductible of \$5000 or 2% of the vessel value (whichever is higher). Members are responsible for the deductible unless they purchase a deductible waiver for \$150 (Sailboats up to 35 feet) or \$250 (Sailboats up to 54 feet) per calendar year

beginning June 1st and ending May 31st. Members who choose to purchase the waiver will only be responsible for up to \$250 of the hull damages per incident. The hull insurance and damage waiver do not cover gross negligence such as driving under the influence, operating the engine continuously at high temperature, sailing in severe weather conditions, sail races, ripped sail, etc, nor does it cover lost items such as anchor, winch handle, fenders, safety kit, etc. Vessels over 32' in length are under the Vessel Assist towing assistance program while in the ocean, on overnight trips or after business hours and can be reached on VHF channel 16; for any other assistance, call the appropriate location on VHF channel 07 or by phone. Charges may apply when assistance is provided.

Member understands and agrees that any damages, rescue or assistance fees, fines and unpaid dues or rental fees will be charged to the credit card on file given by the member. **It is the member responsibility to update Seaforth with any changes pertinent to their credit card number, expiration date, billing address, email address or any necessary financial and contact information. Failure to do so will result in the accumulation of back dues and or a \$99 rejoin fee.**

Reservations

Reservations may be made up to one year prior to start date. Reservations must be canceled 3 or more days prior to reservation date for full refund. (Class cancellations are up to 14 days prior). Reservations will be held for one half hour after reservation start time for late arrivals, after which member will be responsible for 100% of the rental rate, unless equipment is able to be re-rented. **Reservations shall only be confirmed upon full payment less the member dues available by credit card. All online bookings are subject to an online booking fee.**

Seaforth Boat Rentals

Seaforth Boat Rentals offers boat rentals to the public at non-member rates. Member understands that boats are not reserved for the sole use of members and during peak times some boats may not be available. Club members get special rates for sailboat rentals that can be up to 50% off the public rates depending on the vessel. Powerboats up to 20ft are 25% off for Member and Co Member. Stand up paddleboards and kayaks are 50% off Members. Seaforth reserves the right to increase the rental rates without notice including for major Holidays. Club rates are posted on the website and at each specific location, these rates cannot be combined with any special offers, coupons or any other promotions. The day rate can be extended to 23 hours for club members on sailboats 27' and larger based on availability and given an advance notice, 23 hour timeframe starts 10:00am through 9:00am the following day. Additional charges may apply for linens and propane, which needs to be requested by the member at least 72 hours in advance.

Every charter is a bareboat charter in which the member is responsible for ALL provisioning for themselves and their crew.

Member Responsibility

Member agrees that SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB may, at its sole discretion, change, remove, or add boats to the fleet without any liability to the members. All prices posted are subject to change at any time. Boats are available during normal operation at Seaforth Mission Bay, Coronado, Downtown, and Harbor Island Boat Rental. Location hours can vary and change seasonally.

Member will not allow boats to be operated at anytime by anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Member will not allow any illegal drugs to be on board boats at anytime. Red wine and glass bottles are strictly prohibited on board all boats and equipment. Member shall operate the boat in a safe and prudent manner at all times. Member is responsible for boat while docked anywhere other than the Mission Bay, Coronado, or Downtown locations. Member shall be responsible for any and all damage done to boat while in their possession including theft of any kind. Please no black soled or marking shoes on board vessels.

SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB is not responsible for notifying members of weather and or sea conditions. Any assistance needed, such as towing, given to member due to inclement weather, including excessive or a complete lack of wind, is the sole responsibility of the member and may be subject to additional fees. The Member must inspect boat and safety equipment prior to leaving dock and request any equipment that might be necessary (such as winch handle, ocean safety kit, charts, etc.). By taking the boat, member acknowledges that the boat is safe and seaworthy and properly equipped. Upon return, member should notify the dock crew and office of any problem that occurred during the rental. When joining the SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB, a member may receive, upon request, a copy of the California boating laws pamphlet. Coast Guard, State, and local laws must be observed at all times including, but not limited to, the maximum number of passengers allowed on board. Member may not re-charter the boat nor allow anyone other than the person renting the boat to use it. Member may not use boats for any commercial purpose and may not charge any sort of fee for use of the boat. Towing of other vessels is strictly prohibited and subject to fine.

Ocean Sailing and Boating

SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB, at its sole discretion, may determine that weather conditions are unsuitable and prohibit use of the boat. Member agrees that the boats will remain in the protected waters of Mission Bay or San Diego Bay and may not be taken into the open ocean, except those boats that are specifically designated by SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB as ocean going and only if the member has the level of experience or certification required doing so. Member must have prior ocean going experience on respective boat. Member must be aware of Rule G (main channel right of way) that starts from the outside of Buoy 5 when entering the San Diego Harbor channel. When sailing in the Pacific Ocean, member must sail at least 1 mile from the shoreline. Member must be aware of kelp areas and the proper

procedures in case kelp gets entangled on the engine or the keel, overheating of an engine, and any other sea wary procedures.

Extended Trips

Members can take sailboats 27' and larger for multiple days as long as the boat is equipped sufficiently and only if the member has the appropriate level of experience or certification to do so. On extended mileage trips, fuel will be additional. Fuel tank must be re-filled to the same gauge level at which it was received, or a fee of \$6.00 per gallon will be charged for consumption. On trips that extend for two or more days, the holding tank must be emptied prior to return to avoid a \$50 charge. Any fuel receipts must be kept for verification by location manager. Limit 2 free kayaks are available to use as dinghies on extended overnight trips. Improper usage of or clogging head will result in a \$150 repair fee. **Please train your guest(s) on how to properly use the head.** Members are responsible operating, opening, and closing the boat properly and cleaning after use. This is not a complete list of boating rules. Please ask for further information at the location from which you are renting.

Membership Agreement

Member understands and agrees to the terms and conditions of the rental contract for Seaforth Mission Bay, Downtown, Harbor Island, or Coronado Boat Rental which member has signed and received a copy. Member must carry the yellow carbon copy of contract at all times while on or in possession of vessel; it is a legal document that can be requested by law enforcement. It is agreed and understood that if any term, covenant, or provision, of the contract shall be held by a court as invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect and in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated thereby. The "Hold Harmless" clause as well as the general release of liability and other released in the basic "Boat Rental Contract" shall pertain to club members as well as all other items in the rental contract. This document is an integral part of the signed membership agreement and can be modify at any time without notice. The laws of the state of California govern this agreement. SEAFORTH SAILING CLUB IS A DIVISION OF SEAFORTH BOAT RENTALS AND KDME.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS



ASA 101: Basic Keelboat Sailing

Prerequisites: None

Reading Material: Sailing Made Easy by ASA.

Description: This is a two day course, 9am-3pm, students learn to sail a Capri 22' in moderate wind and sea conditions in San Diego/ Mission Bay. A preparatory standard with no navigation skills required. At the end of this class you will be certified to rent and sail up to our 25ft boats in our fleet.

The Cost: Free for members of our Sailing Club, \$99 for club co-members, and \$249 for non-members. Does not include \$39 certification fee.

ASA 101: Take the Challenge

Sailors who already have the skills necessary to pass the Basic Keelboat level can challenge the course. There is a private on the water skills portion, including a knot test, as well as the written exam. Sailors should read Sailing Made Easy by ASA prior for their written exam. The challenge will generally take 3 hours or less to complete.

The Cost: For members, co-members and non-members the cost is \$175. Does not include \$39 certification fee.

SEAFORTH 102: Learn the Ocean

Prerequisites: ASA 101

Description: This clinic is an ocean-based course that qualifies sailors to take our boats offshore. This course includes 4-5 hours with a certified captain on a Capri 22 or Catalina 250. This class prepares sailors for GPS basics, tide charts, reefing, weather preparation, VHF protocol, and emergency protocols. ***Note: Not an ASA class***

The Cost: \$100 for members and non-members.

ASA 103: Basic Coastal Cruising

Prerequisites: ASA 101 + 24 on the water hours

Reading Material: Coastal Cruising Made Easy by ASA

Description: A two-day course going from 9-5 both days. Sailors must cruise safely in local and regional waters as both skipper and crew on an auxiliary powered sailboat in moderate winds and sea conditions.

The Cost: For members and co-members the cost is \$375, and \$495 for non-members.

ASA 104: Bareboat Chartering

Prerequisites: ASA 101 & 103 +50- 80 on the water hours

Reading Material: Bareboat Cruising Made Easy by ASA

Description: This is a two-day live aboard class starting at 9am and finishing at 5pm the following day. Sailors will act as skipper and crew while they practice both day and night sailing in coastal waters. Sailors will gain skills in maintenance, boating systems, navigation, anchoring and more.

The Cost: For members and co-members the cost is \$475 and \$525 for non-members.

ASA 103/104: Combination Class

Prerequisites: ASA 101 + 50- 80 on the water hours

Reading Material: Coastal Cruising Made Easy and Bareboat Cruising Made Easy by ASA.

Description: This is a 3-day local course with dual cruising certification of 103 and 104. This accelerated live aboard course is meant for advanced sailors. You will embark at 9am on a Friday and return Monday at 5pm. Students will have a unique opportunity to learn not only the skills of the 103 and 104, but also how to provision a boat for short term cruising.

The Cost: For members & co-members the cost of the class is \$695 and \$765 for non-members.

ASA 105: Coastal Navigation

Prerequisites: None

Reading Material: Coastal Navigation Book with workbook, practice chart and DVD produced by ASA.

Description: This class is taught as a home study. Students must demonstrate the navigational theory required to safely navigate a sailing vessel in coastal or inland waters. There are no sailing skills as part of this standard; the skills are incorporated into the ASA 106 Advanced Coastal Cruising Standard.

The Cost: For members, co-members, and non-members testing and certification only, the cost is \$135. Tutoring available at \$25/ hour, 2-hour minimum.

ASA 106: Advanced Coastal Cruising

Prerequisites: ASA 101, 103, 104, & 105

Reading Material: Annapolis Book of Seamanship by John Rousmaniere and Mark Smith.

Description: This is a four-day live aboard course to Catalina, which leaves at 9am and returns in the evening of the fourth day. Sailors will act both as skipper and crew. This is a day and night- time standard in coastal and inland water and in any weather.

The Cost: For members & co-members the cost of the class is \$900 and \$975 for non-members.

ASA 114: Cruising Catamaran

Prerequisites: ASA 101, 103, & 104

Reading Material: Cruising Catamaran Made Easy by ASA

Description: This class is a two day course that teaches sailors catamaran structure, components and features, performance under sail and power, boat systems, seamanship and safety, heavy weather operation, and emergency response.

The Cost: \$375 for members and \$425 for non-members.

With a minimum of 3 students, any class can be organized with advance notice. PRIVATE CLASSES can also be arranged to fit your schedule. Please give us a call if you have any questions.

SEAFORTH SAIL CLUB EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Fall Pro-Series Races: (One time per month, October thru March)

Price: \$70 per boat, split up among crew members.

Location: Coronado

These races are recommended for more seasoned and competitive sailors but everyone is more than welcome to join! We use our Capri 22 foot boats for the race and there are usually 3-4 crew members per boat, but can have up to 6 members. Teams are formed at the beginning of the season in October and race together for the entirety of the series. This series is a great opportunity to improve a wide range of sailing skills while adding a strategic element to your knowledge. You will also get the chance to learn from and teach other club members while growing your sailing network.

Pau Hana Summer Series: (Runs every Thursday at 5pm, April-September)

Price: \$10 per member, \$15 per non-member

Location: Mission Bay

These races are structured for sailors of all skill levels! We also use our Capri 22 foot boats for this series and we can fit up to four members and or non members per boat. This series is good for all levels because all boats and have an experienced club member aboard to guide the crew. This is good for introducing your friends to sailing, greatly improving your sailing knowledge, and introducing yourself to the sail racing community!

Quarterly regattas, Winter, Spring, and Fall)
