JOB DESCRIPTION

You will direct and care for 4 to 8 guests in 15' -16' rafts with a stern-mount oar rig, on class 1/2 and 2/3 rivers while providing engaging and witty dialogue, and be an ambassador of our family-friendly, safe operation.

DUTIES

Once you successfully complete training, you'll be given at least 33 hours a week of paid work. This will include as much guiding as possible, but will be supplemented by shuttle and operation tasks. Additional duties: pre and post-trip set up, safety boating, shuttles and other operation-related tasks

TRAINING

All guides must demonstrate 35 industry-standard competencies and learn company policies and procedures over a 10 to 14-day program. BCROA and PROAOA guide certifications are available.

COMPANY INFORMATION

Wild Blue Yonder Rafting has been operating trips on class 2 to class 4+ rivers in Grande Cache, Alberta since 1998, and in Revelstoke since 2016. We belong to the British Columbia River Outfitters Association and the Professional River Outfitters Association of Alberta. QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum one season (or 50 hours) of recreational or commercial paddling on class 3 rivers. This could be rafting, canoeing or kayaking. Or, a raft guide training program from a recognized institution. We require the following certifications:

- Standard First Aid / CPR (Wilderness First Aid preferred)
- Swiftwater Rescue Technician*
- BCROA, PROAOA or IRF Raft Guide certificate*
