PADI Adventures in Diving and Advanced Open Water Itinerary

Adventure diver Course prerequisites:

- Students must be at least 10 years of age. (age 10-15 earn jr certification)
- must have open water or jr open water certification
- Students under the age of 18 must have the signature of a parent or guardian.

Advanced Diver course prerequisites:

- Students must be 12 years old (Age 12-15 earn jr certification)
- Must have open water or jr open water certification
- Students under the age of 18 must have the signature of a parent or guardian.

Course *Includes:* PADI Adventures in diving manual logbook (if doing book course), deluxe data carrier, use of videos or DVD, instruction, boat or shore dives and use of all equipment.

Student to provide: Log book, proof of open water certification, towel.

Dives required Adventures in diving: 3*

Dives required Advanced Open Water: 5*

*Most of our boat diving trips take place as two tank dive excursions to add a dive to your class you can add a fun dive as an additional charge or you can earn an extra certification and take 50% off any 2 dive specialty of your choice!

Advanced open water

Deep** (70 ft 12- 15 year old) (100 feet maximum 15 years old and up) Navigation

COURSE ITINERARY

Before dive portion of course begins

Check in at dive shop to fill paperwork and pick up materials. Pick up Padi Advanced Open Water Diver Course DVD. Read course manual chapters of dives you are completing. Deep and Navigation are required if you are completing Advanced Open water course. Please also choose three electives and complete knowledge reviews. It is a good idea to have an extra chapter or two read and knowledge reviews filled out in case conditions aren't favorable for one of your dive choices. Knowledge reviews MUST be completed before doing dives.

(This is the home study portion of the course. You are of course welcome to use the classroom facilities at our dive center.)

Day 1 AM

7:30 AM -1:30 PM check in at dive center for two adventure dives. Turn in knowledge reviews to instructor. After dives complete log book entries.

Day 2 AM

7:30AM-1:30 PM check in at dive center for one or two more dives if doing advanced this will be your deep dive day. Turn in knowledge reviews to instructor. After dives complete log book entries.

Day 3 PM

Time is seasonal this is a great time to do night dive if that is one of you elective dives. See options below

This is just a sample itinerary there are lots of options for completing adventure diver or advanced open water certification. If you plan on doing all boat dives and are either doing two 2 tank dive trips for adventure or three 2 tank dive trips for advanced you can either pay for the additional "fun dive" (they are all fun but this won't be an in training dive) or use it to complete a specialty course and get a specialty certification card as well see options below. You will receive 50% off your specialty certification if you use this option.
