Dear Customer:

Shenandoah Valley Railroad (SVRR) is amending Demurrage Tariff SVRR 2001 effective April 20, 2021. Demurrage Tariff SVRR 2001 contains general car demurrage rules and charges and switching and terminal rules and charges. The revisions will be incorporated as Supplement 1 to this tariff and are available to view on the SVRR website at: www.mountainrail.com.

Below is a brief description of the changes.

Demurrage Tariff SVRR 2001, Naming General Car Demurrage Rules and Charges and Switching and Terminal Rules and Charges:

- Section A, Item 004 – Demurrage Charges.

UPDATE paragraph (A): Chargeable days will be computed at a rate of **\$60.00** per car per day, except for refrigerated cars, which will be computed at a rate of **\$120.00** per chargeable day.

UPDATE paragraph (D): Customer will be allowed one (1) credit day for unloading.

- Section A, Item 005 – Free Time.

UPDATE: The customer will be allowed one (1) day for loading and one (1) day for unloading.

- Section C – Demurrage Application.

UPDATE: Railroad cars, including “railroad controlled private equipment” will have one (1) loading credit and one (1) unloading credit and will be assessed demurrage at a per car daily rate of \$60.00.

UPDATE: Empty cars and locomotives moving on own wheels in revenue service (STCC 37 411 XX and 37 422 XX) will have one (1) origin credit and one (1) destination credit and will be assessed demurrage at a per car daily rate of \$60.00.

NEW: Refrigerated cars for loading or unloading in railroad equipment and industry-controlled private railcars will receive one (1) loading credit and one (1) unloading credit and will be assessed demurrage at a per car daily rate of \$120.00.
