Failure to include an SAE will result in failed entry. Please complete a separate form for each vehicle. Vehicles should be ready for exhibition at the site by 10am on each day. The Gala will close at 5pm both days. Entries will close on **1st June 2024**. Vehicle entry is **FREE**. Exhibitors will receive a number of discounted tickets to travel on the railway. Any additional passengers must pay normal rates to travel on the railway. Free vehicle entry and discounted admission tickets are only valid if arriving with the vehicle you have entered. All visiting vehicles must be insured for use both on and off the highway. Driving of vehicles on the rally field must be by authorised and insured drivers holding a full driving licence for the class of vehicle involved. Please note that drinking and driving legislation also applies to off public road driving. Under NO circumstances can a vehicle be brought and/or displayed on TRADE PLATES. The instructions of Llangollen Railway Marshalls must be followed at all times.
