Marvellous Minibeasts

A fully immersive hands on experience to discover the hidden world of the minibeasts.

Children are introduced to animals from different habitats, and we explore what they are, and where they are from.

This workshop is best suited as a sensory experience for younger groups but can be adapted for older children as a stepping stone for further research back in the classroom.

Roots, Shoots, Flowers and Leaves

Children will never forget the parts of the plant after discovering them inside the tropical hothouse. The lesson also focuses on the functions of the plant parts, and the role of plants in the environment.

Workshops last 60 minutes, leaving time for lunch and self guided exploration. Start time is 10.30am.

All workshops and tours are linked to the current and new curriculum's and cover the following topics:

National Curriculum links: Science, living things and their habitats, life processes and living things, geography knowledge and understanding of different places, PHSE & Citizenship, Science & Plants; explore the requirements of plants for life and growth.

New 2022 Curriculum links: Diversity of life, observing living things, exploring natural habitats, interacting with the environment, humans form part of the living world, ethical and informed citizens, structure and function of living things, conditions living things need to survive.
