Down:

- 4.) Native American who first met the English at Plymouth.
- 5.) This tribe has a Houlton Band made up of about 1,700 members which is a smaller band of the larger Nation in New Brunswick, Canada.

Across:

- 1.) A statue, building, or other structure built to commemorate a famous or notable person or event.
- 2.) A type of lesser chief in a tribe
- 3.) This word means "People of the Eastern Dawn."
