Rangers will also provide high quality animal care through enrichment, training, and diet construction. These are full-time, seasonal positions lasting from the end of April until November 1, 2022.

Qualified candidates must be able to follow instructions, handle money, and maintain a calm and friendly demeanor. Previous industry experience is strongly preferred. Must be able to work in a variety of conditions and lift 50 pounds. Applicants should have an outgoing personality, excellent communication skills, attention to detail, and an interest in working at one of Walworth County's top attractions.
