

How to Enter 2022 Dickinson County Fair

1. Pre-Registration is required! Entry form must be completed and returned to the Dickinson County Fair Office P.O. Box 192 Norway, Michigan 49870 no later than the third Tuesday of August. Also include a completed W-9 form, fee form and fee. After the third Friday of August there will be a Late Entry Fee of \$10.00 per exhibitor. Late entries will be accepted up to 3 days prior to start of fair.
2. Exhibitor Number is the first initial of exhibitor's last name plus the last 4 digits of their social security number.
3. Use a different entry form for each age group (Youth - Open).
4. For stall and pen space contact the superintendent.
5. Entry day for all animals is Wednesday from 4:00 - 10:00pm. NO ANIMAL CAN BE UNLOADED WITHOUT A SUPERINTENDENT PRESENT.
6. Entry day for all other animals is Wednesday from 9:00am - 5:00pm. NO ANIMAL CAN BE UNLOADED WITHOUT A SUPERINTENDENT PRESENT.
7. All other still exhibits will be entered on Wednesday from 10:00am - 8:00pm to the designated location.
8. All entries are the property of the Dickinson County Fair until Monday at 5:00pm when all entries are released.
9. ANY ENTRY leaving before 5:00pm on Monday will forfeit all premiums unless permitted by fairboard.
10. All entries must be picked up between 5:00 and 6:00pm on Monday.
11. Any premium check not cashed within 180 days will be considered a donation and the check will be voided.
