

SEMAPHORE

Patented in the 1840s, this is one of the earliest and most widely used forms of mechanical railroad signals. They were used to communicate information to engineers and conductors, called aspects. In Ringoes, our semaphore aspect reads "STOP."



CABOOSE

The caboose is one of the most recognizable pieces of railroad rolling stock. They had many uses, but are best known for acting as rolling offices for a train's crew.
