Nor-Cal Charters is taking a number of steps to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus) and keep our vessels as safe as possible. Please read below for some information regarding travel and check back later as we will continue to provide updates as they are available.

What is Nor-Cal Charters doing to limit the spread of COVID-19?

All common-touch areas on our vessels are being routinely cleaned, and workers are reminded to practice good hygiene. These are high touch public spaces, and it's important for the public to also do your part to protect yourselves and others by practicing good hygiene and canceling your travel plans if you are sick.

- Staff will maintain social distancing during our charters to the greatest extent possible
- Our boats are now equipped with personal protective gear for our crew.
- Our crew has been provided a generous sick-day policy that will encourage them to stay home if they feel coming to work will impact their safety or the safety of others.
- Boats will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized after each charter
- Food services are suspended or will be limited to individually wrapped items.
- While operating, cabin windows will be open and air ventilation systems will be running to expel air outside.
- Nor-Cal Charters will be constantly reviewing and updating these policies based on the most current guidance from federal and state agencies.
