Employees of Pacific Whale Foundation and their immediate family members are not eligible to win.

Winners will be notified by mail within 60 days. Prizes must be claimed within one calendar year.

There is no cash redemption or substitution of any of the prizes in the Wild & Wonderful Whale Regatta.
